

GUIDELINES FOR PAPER PRESENTATION - FLAIR 2024

1. Abstract must be sent on or before October 25, 2024 as per the instruction given below. Failure to follow the instruction provided will disqualify from presentation.
2. Time duration must be limited to 5 minutes + 2 minutes for interrogation
3. Number of paper presentation for a college is limited to

COMPETITIVE CATEGORY (for Students)	NON – COMPETITIVE CATEGORY (For Professional)
Post graduate – 2 students	Faculty – 2 professionals from each College/Institution
Under graduate – 2 students	Clinical therapists – 2professionals from each Hospital/Centre/Clinic

4. The submitting author must be the presenting author, as correspondence will be with the presenting author, although presenting author does not have to be the first named author listed on the abstract. The presenter's name has to be highlighted in the abstract.
5. Each prospective presenter may submit and present only one abstracts. They may be named on other abstracts as a co-author.
6. For PG and Professional only one presenting author per paper is permitted, for UG two others may present If no author is available the abstract will be withdrawn.
7. All presentations must describe original work to which all the authors listed have made a significant contribution.
8. It is the responsibility of the author to submit an accurate abstract. Abstracts will be published in FLAIR conference proceeding in renowned Indexed Journal (No corrections/ editing will be done by conference committee, kindly follow the guidelines of abstract).
9. Abstracts whose authors do not register with full payment before the last date (i.e.October 30, 2024) will be withdrawn.
10. Presenting authors only will receive a certificate of presentation.
11. PPTs of presentation with a separate profile slide containing name and the photo of candidate, college name with logo, etc. must be mailed to flaircon@svcopt.ac.in on or before 30th October 2024 with subject name 'Paper presentation'[No pendrives will be accepted in order to avoid file corruption]

12. Already published paper / poster is not allowed to be presented as per the concern of fair proceeding publication.
13. All decisions of the Programme Committee will be final.

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT

The body of the abstract is limited to 250 words (excluding the title and information on authors) and shall be under following headings

ABSTRACT	
Title	TITLE OF THE ABSTRACT
Author (s)	Name with affiliation
Purpose	What was the major reason for doing the study? Any secondary objectives!
Methods & Materials	What methodological approach was used for the study including the participants details and the methods used for data collection?
Results	Briefly summarize the main findings derived from your analysis.
Conclusion	What can be concluded from the analysis of your data? What are the suggestions for future work?
Implications	How does this study contribute for physiotherapy practice/management/education/policy.
Keywords	Minimum 3 and maximum 5 words to describe your work which are supplementary to the topic.

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER – FLAIR 2024

1. Number of posters per college is limited to 2 (Undergraduates students & Postgraduate students can apply).
2. Undergraduate students posters can be any type of review or original research paper. Postgraduate posters must be original research paper or systematic review (other types of review will not be accepted)
3. Poster space allocation is 3*4 feet Flex (potrait). Any posters that exceed this size will not be displayed.
4. Abstract of the Poster should include the name(s) and affiliation of the author(s), kindly avoid mentioning it in the printed poster.

5. All text font, diagrams and photographs should be large enough to be legible at a distance of 1.5m. Font used should be 24 point minimum (preferably Times Roman font).
6. The use of figures and charts is suggested, avoid excessive text.
7. Softcopy of the posters and a separate profile slide containing name and the photo of candidate, college name with logo, etc. are also requested to be mailed too flaircon@svcopt.ac.in on or before October 25,2024 with subject name 'Poster presentation'
8. Only original research article will be published in conference proceeding.
[Already published papers / posters are not allowed to be presented as per the concern of flair proceeding publication.]
9. In case of research poster use the following guidelines for Abstract.
 - Title and contents: In English
 - Authors: should include the name(s) and affiliation of the author(s) to facilitate identification at the conference.
 - Purpose
 - Method and Materials
 - Result (Captions and headings for photographs, tables, figures etc)
 - Conclusion
 - Implication
 - References (limited to a minimum of 3 &maximum of5)
 - Font style: Times New Roman, Size –12.
- 10.All decisions of the Programme Committee will be final.

GUIDELINES FOR PHYSIO SPARK – FLAIR

2024

Innovations should be in the field of Physiotherapy Health Care related such as mobile app, machine tool, Assesment tool, wearable gadgets, treatment tool etc.

Eligibility

1. The competition is open to physiotherapy students, professionals, and researchers (Common-single category).
2. The preference will be given to ideas that have reached the prototype stage and are available to display during the conference.
3. Participants can enter individually or in teams (max 5 members). However only one person can present the idea.

Submission Guidelines

1. Participants must submit a written proposal (max 2 pages) outlining their innovative idea or solution.
2. Proposals must include:
 - Problem statement
 - Solution description
 - Potential impact/Implication
 - Feasibility and implementation plan
3. Submissions must be original and not previously published or patented/copyrighted
4. Submissions must not have received or be under consideration for any grants.

Competition Phases

1. **Idea Submission:** Participants submit their written proposals.
2. **Short listing:** A panel of judges selects top proposals based on innovation, impact, and feasibility.
3. **Pitching:** Shortlisted participants present their ideas to the judges and audience.

4. **Winners Announcement:** Judges declare the winners.

Judging Criteria

1. Innovation (30%)
2. Impact (25%)
3. Feasibility (20%)
4. Presentation (25%)

Prizes

1. Winner: Cash prize Rs. 3000/memento and/or mentorship opportunity
2. Runner-up: Cash prize Rs. 2000/memento and/or recognition
3. Consolation Prize: Cash prize Rs. 1000/memento

Intellectual Property

1. Participants retain ownership of their ideas and solutions.
2. By participating, participants grant the organizers permission to showcase their ideas. Prize recipients should acknowledge "Sri Venkateshwaraa College of Physiotherapy, Ariyur, Puducherry" when presenting or publishing their papers.

Timeline

1. Idea submission deadline: October 25,2024
2. Shortlisting announcement: October 30,2024

Miscellaneous

1. Participants must agree to the rules and terms and conditions.
2. The organizers reserve the right to modify the rules or cancel the competition if necessary.

GUIDELINES FOR QUIZ

1. Participant must pay a registration fee of Rs.100/- for participating in quiz (Apart from conference registration)
2. No restriction in number of team per college in Preliminary round. The candidates participating in Final (main) round must be same as Preliminary

round, exchange of candidates are not allowed after preliminary round.

3. Each team must contain 3 participants
4. Questions will be based on BPT syllabus
5. Final **six(6)** teams for the quiz will be selected based on the score of the preliminary round
6. Slide containing the team member profile which includes name and photo of candidate, batch and year, college name with logo are requested to be mailed on or before October 30, 2024 to flaircon@svcopt.ac.in with subject name 'Quiz'

CULTURAL GUIDELINES:

1. Each participants should carry identity proof
2. Students taking part in the events should make your entry on the day of fest at the cultural committee, near registration desk. Spot entry is not obliged.
3. Students should refrain from the abusive language, obscene display and revealing costumes during the competitions, failing which they will be disqualified.
4. Smoking, drinking and consumption of any such 'substance' are prohibited
5. Participants should go through the event rules and adhere to the specific participation.
6. Props, music for the performances are to be carried by the participants. No fire related objects are strictly prohibited.
7. The judge's decision is final
8. A participant can participate only in one event during the simultaneous timing for events; a participant is not restricted to participation in any number of events as long as the event timings do not clash.
9. Vulgarity is strongly prohibited. Any form of obscenity, unparliamentarily word, indecent exposure will lead to debarring the participant from the contest
10. All the events will be commence at the scheduled time; punctuality will be appreciated
11. If participants are not present at the time of the event – they will be disqualified.
12. Criteria for overall championship include participation in maximum number of scientific events as well as the total scores obtained from the various competitions.
13. Rules are subject to change at the discretion of the conference organizers and jury.

CULTURAL EVENTS (RULES AND REGULATIONS)

DAY: 1 (OFF STAGE)

FACE PAINTING:

- Theme based on **serve the needy**
- Maximum 2 entries per college
- 2 members per team (1 model and 1 artist) nonparticipants are not allowed
- Time duration for this session 1 hour
- Winner will be selected in the basis of clarity, theme and duration

PHOTOGRAPHY:

Theme based on **serve the needy**

- Maximum 2 entries per college
- Photos will be placed in front of the judges
- Best photography award will be selected by the judge in the basis of theme and originality

ON STAGE

SINGING (DUET):

- Maximum 2 entries per college
- Time duration max 5 minutes
- Participants should submit the music track and karaoke to the cultural coordinator prior to the event
- Judgment is based on the vocal clarity, sync and song selection
- Negative marks given for extra time consumption

GROUP DANCE (WESTERN AND FOLK):

- Maximum number of entries 1 team per college(max 8 per team)
- Time limit max 8 min timing should be strictly followed
- No of participants 1 team per college
- Props are allowed, but not stage sets
- Participants should submit the music tract and karaoke to the coordinator prior to the event
- Judging criteria: proficiency of steps, costumes, choreography, expressions, coordination, stage coverage and overall appearance.

- In case of any discrepancies, the decision of the judge is considered final
- Negative mark will be given for the extra time consumption

MR AND MISS FLAIR:

- Time limit : For each team about 8-10 minutes {including introduction and intervals between rounds}
- Number of participants can be max 10 members per college.
- The team can depict any theme of their choice.
- Song selection (own wish)
- Vulgarity is strongly prohibited. Any form of obscenity, indecent exposure will lead to debarring the participant from the contest.
- Decision of the judges is final and binding.
- Judging criteria: Creativity, modeling, appeal and overall impact.

VARIETY SHOW (Mime, movie spoof, talent show)

MIME:

- Open theme
- Background music is allowed. (with prior submission)
- No offensive and disrespectful content
- **JUDGMENT:** based on the depth of the content, sync, properties used and acting.

MOVIE SPOOF:

TOPIC: Movie of your choice (language from Tamil/English)

- **JUDGING CRITERIA:** content and clarity, voice modulation, pronunciation, costumes, AV, humor, creativity, audience response.

TALENT SHOW:

- Participants can exhibit their talent through this show
- Number of entries 2 per college
- Participants should carry their own instruments if require
- Judges decision will be final

GUIDLINES FOR ABOVE VARIETY SHOW

- Number of teams per college 1- team

- Number of participants per team: 8-10
- Time duration for the performance 10 minutes
- No separate time for the introduction and of team and their theme
- Audio recordings should be sent to incharge 2 days before the day of the event (Pendrive with audio should be brought on the day of event).
- Props for the performances are to be carried by the participants
- Stage sets like chairs, tables etc., will be provided only if informed 2 days prior to the event.
- Judges decision will be final.
- Judging Criteria: Creativity, on stage delivery, No of varieties, Voice clarity and pronunciation, audience response

SHORT FILM:

- Theme – (social media addiction, online harassment, A women of substance)
- Max 1 entries per college
- Time duration 10mins max (from title to end card)
- Judgment is based on the cinematography, acting, editing, theme and background scoring
- Selected short film will be featured on the stage

DAY: 2

OFF STAGE EVENTS:

POETRY:

- Theme - The Physiotherapist vision (Tamil/English)
- Max 2 entries per college
- 1 prize will be selected by the judge in the basis of theme and originality
- Vulgar content will be disqualified
- Poetry to be submitted in JPEG format through whatsapp before 2 days of the event

NAIL ART:

- Number of entries 2 per college (1 artist and 1 model)
- Open theme

- The participants should bring their own materials and model
- The Judging criteria is based on nail shape, creativity, level of difficulty, use of the colour and overall workmanship
- nonparticipants are not to be allowed

ON STAGE EVENTS:

ADAPT TUNE:

- Max 2 entries per college.
- Time allotted for 3 min.
- Mixed music will be played on the spot.
- The participants will have to dance according to the theme
- Judgement is based on consistent moves to adapt the tune.
- Participants must report at the venue 15 minutes before the commencement of the event.

FUN GAME:

- Fun games will be conducted in the leisure time
- All the conference delegates can be participate in the fun game on spot.

- VOLLEYBALL (MEN)
- THROWBALL (WOMEN)
- FUTSAL (MEN)
- BADMINTON (MEN & WOMEN)
- CARRROM (MEN & WOMEN)
- CHESS (MEN & WOMEN)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

VOLLEYBALL - MEN

- One team per college is allowed to give entry.
- Tournament will be conducted in knockout basis.
- Team must consist of 10 players (6 main + 4 subs)
- Each match consist of a best of three set and each set of 25 points.
- Standard rotation is to be followed.
- Incase of rain, points of each set will be reduced.

THROWBALL – WOMEN

- One team per college is allowed to give entry.
- Tournament will be conducted in knockout basis.
- Team must consist of 10 players (7 main + 3 subs)
- The match is played for 3 sets of 25 points in each set.
- The ball should be served by released from above the shoulder / shoulder line of the player.
- Players are not allowed to shift the ball from right to left or left or right.
- Double touches are not allowed.
- Standard rotation is to be followed.
- In case of rain, points of each set will be reduced.

FUTSAL - MEN

- One team per college is allowed to give entry.
- Tournament will be conducted in knockout basis.
- Team must consist of 8 players (5 main player + 3 subs)
- The match duration: 8 mins -3break - 8 mins.
- Rolling substitutions will be observed.

- In case of draw will be decided by penalty shootout.
- Referee decision will be final.

BADMINTON (MEN & WOMEN)

- 2 (one men and one women) team per college is allowed to give entry.
- Team events – doubles (single set of 30 points)
- Yonex mavis 350 shuttlecocks are used.
- Non marking shoes are mandatory.

CARROM (MEN & WOMEN)

- 2 (One men and one women) teams per college is allowed to give entry.
- 2 players per team – only doubles,
- Only one hand should be used throughout the game.
- Thumbing is not allowed.
- Hands shouldn't be placed on the board during the match.
- Participants should bring their own strikers.

CHESS (MEN & WOMEN)

- 2 (one men and one women) teams per college is allowed to give entry.
- 3 players per team.
- Timing – 10 minutes on each match.
- More than 2 illegal moves lead to disqualification.
